


Project Catalyst is the world's largest decentralised grant funding platform for solving real-world challenges. At the start of each funding round, the Cardano community proposes ideas that solve challenges within the blockchain ecosystem and the wider world.

The community then evaluates and votes on which technical, business, creative, and community projects will receive funding.

### **Objective**


Discuss and identify key innovation areas for funding, based on analysis of past initiatives and future needs.

Consider how innovation areas that require funding can be measured for signals that the investment is returning ecosystem value.


#### **Tasks**




### Questions


- What are Cardano ecosystem priorities that funding should be deployed towards?



Reach a group consensus for your top answers from each question you answered.


#### **Tasks**


